The following items should not be placed in the skip

Fridges and Freezers

Liquids and Oils

Waste Electrical Equipment (WEEE Waste) including TV and Computer monitors

Fluorescent Light Tubes

Hazardous Waste

Medical Waste

Tyres

Paint Tins

Batteries

Gas Bottles

Plasterboard

Skips should only be filled to a level load no higher than the top of the skip

No fires are allowed in the skip.

Skips placed on the public highway or verge will require a licence issued by the local authority. Please give us a call to discuss.

Suitable access must be provided for our vehicle to deliver a skip to your property. Whilst our experienced drivers will take the upmost care we accept no liability for any damage incurred during delivery or collection of skips.
